Top 5 platforms pupils feel unsafe using

New research has uncovered the top five platforms young people feel the most unsafe whilst using. The results are as follows:

- Roblox (15%)
- Snapchat (12%)
- Instagram (7%)
- TikTok (6%)
- Fortnite (4%)

There will always be risks for many social media platforms and games such as stranger interaction, inappropriate content, profile sharing and bullying. There are ways to stay safe.

Top Tips are:

- Talk about online privacy and information sharing.
- Get involved! See for yourself what the game involves so that you have a better understanding of what your child is experiencing
- Have conversations about image sharing. Talk about what's appropriate to share online and what to do if someone asks them to send a photo, video or message that makes them feel uncomfortable.
- Discuss FOMO and social media pressure. Remind them that if they are uncomfortable or don't want to do something, they do not have to do it. They might be feeling pressure to 'look popular' or not be 'boring'. Discuss these feelings and how to achieve a healthy balance between online and offline.
