## **English**


We will also be reading this text and exploring the key VIPERS skills in our shared reading sessions.

#### Maths

In Maths we will be focusing multiplication, division and fractions, as well as continuing to refine our methods for the four operations.

## **IPC**

IPC topics this term are History based, and called 'The Great, the Bold and the Brave.' We will be focusing on the Ancients Greeks and Romans, as well as aspects of the Persian War. We will also be learning about Ancient Greek Art and designing and creating our own pots.









#### Homework

Homework will be given out weekly and will include Maths, and Spelling, along with some IPC or Reading. It should be submitted by Wednesday morning at the latest.

Reading must be done at least x3 per week and reading records should be brought in every day. Spelling tests will be weekly.

# Uniform
