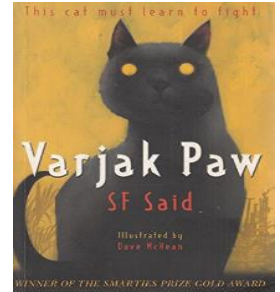




The term ahead: Summer 2 in Year 4
