What the children will be learning about:

In English, we will be writing dialogues through narratives, children will be learning and implementing the skills of direct speech, the rules of inverted commas and exploring synonyms for 'said'. Alongside this, we will be continuing to read The Chronicles of Narnia and discovering the adventure of two friends being hurled into another world. In Maths we will continue recapping the four operations to support children's fluency as well as learning about fractions, money and shape.

This term in Spanish, our topic continues on with 'la fruta'. We will be building on from our last topic which was about vegetables! As for R.E, we will be focusing on Christianity and why the holy Bible is important. In P.E the children will be learning how to play golf, focussing on all of the skills.

Geography will be travel and tourism, with a focus on the how Tourism impacts different countries.
