Maths – Length and Perimeter

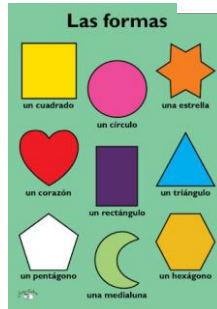
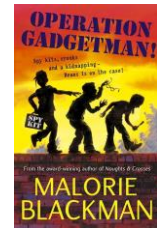
