What the children will be learning about:

In English, we will be writing 3rd person narratives revolving around the way animals move and hunt. Our texts will be based upon a day in the life of both predator and prey. The children will be focussing on descriptive language and using both adjectives and adverbs to support the description.

We will be continuing to read Operation Gadgetman and become immersed in the way and life of a spy.

In Maths we will be recapping the four operations to support the children's fluency as well as learning how to add and subtract fractions.

In Spanish will be covering fruits and vegetables.

R.E will be focussing on the importance of holy books.

In P.E, the children will be working on a variety of different skills in athletics track and field.

Geography will be all about island life with a focus on hemispheres and grid coordinates.
