

Year 1 Spring 2 Newsletter

We hope you had a lovely break and are ready for another brilliant half-term in Year One. Our topic is 'Time Travellers' and we will be learning about key events of the Great Fire of London.

English

The children will be planning and writing a story with a familiar setting. They will apply their knowledge of adjectives to describe the settings within stories and they will also extend their sentences using the conjunction 'and'. Children will be writing a recount based on their personal experience making sure we use our punctuation (full stops, capital letters and exclamation marks)

Phonics/Reading

Children will continue with their daily phonics sessions following the Little Wandle scheme.

Our focus texts in our reading sessions this half-term are: 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers and 'Chocolate Cake' by Michael Rosen.

Maths

The children will learn about the place value of numbers to 50. They will build on their knowledge of tens and ones within 20 to develop an understanding of the composition of numbers to 50. Children will explore measurement through length, height as well as mass and volume. We will use our new knowledge to develop our problem solving and reasoning skills.

Topic

Our topic this half term is 'Time Travellers'. The children will be learning about how artefacts and other sources of information can tell us about the past. They will be thinking about their own lives and ordering important events on a timeline. Our focus event is 'The Great Fire of London'. We will be looking at different materials and their properties in Science and in D&T we will be making our own houses to recreate the Great Fire to understand 'how did the fire start and spread?'
