


A Message from Year 3


Writing

We begin this term with writing third person narratives. We will focus on how to sustain the third person perspective and the past tense. Looking at how best to select vocabulary to create atmosphere and finally how to use similes and metaphors as descriptive devices.

Next, we will be looking at different styles of letter writing including how to write a formal letters of complaint.

Maths

In maths we will be learning about fractions and mass and capacity.



Wider curriculum

Our **Geography** topic this term is called “Travel and Tourism.” We will look at places that we can travel to from our local airports, the consequences of over tourism and the environmental impact of flying.
